

CABINET OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE MANUAL

CLEANING

Wipe cabinets down occasionally with the correct cleaning agent, but don't keep wet towels or dish rags on them for too long to avoid warping or ruining the finish.

BASIC KITCHEN CABINET CARE

For kitchen cabinets made from finished wood, use cleaners specifically designed for wood cabinets or furniture. Avoid the use of caustic or abrasive cleaners. If your wooden kitchen cabinets appear dull after cleaning, apply a wood wax for added luster.

EXTRA KITCHEN CABINET CARE

If advanced cleaning of your kitchen cabinets is necessary due to long-term neglect, an all-purpose cleaner is appropriate for metal or plastic surfaces. On a kitchen cabinet made from finished wood, you may need to use a solvent such as paint thinner to deal with excessive grime.

Be very cautious when using solvents. Avoid open flames and use proper ventilation. To avoid further damage to your kitchen cabinet finish, apply the solvent to the inside of the cabinet door first and see how it responds.

REPAIR KNICKS AND SCRATCHES

Use Mstone® provided extra stain kit for touch-up of knicks and scratches. Apply coats of stain and/or finishes very thinly. Always use a tack cloth for stain touch-ups.
